### **Election Signage**

With election season upon us, a reminder of the bylaws on displaying election signs:

- Political signs advocating the election of an individual or individuals to public office, which are no larger than 22" by 14", may be displayed from the window of a unit. Such signs may be displayed no earlier than thirty days prior to the election and must be removed no later than ten days following such election.
