### **Committee Highlight - Landscape**

Did you know the Landscape Committee is one of the busiest year-round groups in our association? With so much beautiful green space and mature trees throughout Pheasant Run, there's a lot to enjoy - and a lot to maintain.

The committee supports the Board of Directors by reviewing and advising on the maintenance and appearance of the community's common area landscaping. Its work includes monitoring lawns, flower beds, trees, rock walls, irrigation systems, and snow removal, as well as evaluating maintenance needs and recommending service providers. All recommendations are communicated to the Board through the committee chairperson to help inform planning and budgeting decisions. The committee has three primary members (Betsy Royals, Terry Royals, Ellen Sternig) and volunteers who help with specific tasks.

### **Landscape Captains**

The committee is looking for additional volunteers to serve as captains - residents who help the Landscape Committee keep our neighborhood looking attractive.

Landscape captains generally work in pairs to walk around designated common areas using a simple checklist to spot issues such as damaged plantings, irrigation concerns, or areas needing cleanup. Most routes take only a couple of hours to complete, and their observations play a big role in helping the committee address problems early and maintain the high standards we all appreciate.
